



Enrollment is simple! It starts with your iTunes account.

Please note: To ensure your enrollment goes smoothly, you must use the same contact information for your iTunes and Apple Pay accounts that you use for your CAMPUS Visa Platinum credit or debit card. If there is a discrepancy, it will delay your enrollment. If your phone number, email address or mailing address has changed but you have not yet updated that contact information in your CAMPUS or iTunes account, you should update the incorrect information before enrolling in Apple Pay.

If your CAMPUS Visa Platinum credit card or debit card is already connected to your iTunes account, just enter the card's security code when you enroll in Apple Pay. If your CAMPUS Visa Platinum credit or debit card is not currently connected to your iTunes account, it's still easy to add it into Apple Pay: just load your CAMPUS Visa Platinum credit or debit card into Passbook. After you've enrolled your CAMPUS Visa Platinum credit or debit card, it's easy to make it your default payment option:

- If your CAMPUS card is the first card you enrolled into Apple Pay, you don't have to do anything! It is already your default card.
- If a different card is your current default, just open "Passbook & Apple Pay" (in Settings), then click "Default Card" and select the CAMPUS Visa Platinum credit or debit card in the displayed list of your enrolled cards.

How to Use Apple Pay in Participating Stores:

1. Look for the Pay Wave® or Apple Pay symbol at checkout and hold your phone near the contactless reader.



2. Place your finger on the Touch ID™. Or, you may need to enter a passcode and sign a receipt.

3. Keep your phone by the reader until it vibrates and beeps, indicating your payment was accepted.

Making payments with Apple Pay is easy. The entire transaction is secure, as your credit and debit card numbers aren't stored on the device or on Apple's® server, so they're never shared with the merchant. And, if your iPhone is ever lost or stolen, just use the "Find My iPhone" feature.

Notice to CAMPUS Visa debit cardholders:

CAMPUS recommends that you select "credit" when paying with a debit card, because older merchant payment terminals may not always work successfully with debit cards in Apple Pay. Apple, the Apple logo, and iPhone are trademarks of Apple Inc., registered in the U.S. and other countries. Apple Pay is a trademark of Apple Inc.

FAQ:

1. What is Apple Pay?

Apple Pay allows you to pay for your purchases with your iPhone® 6 or iPhone 6 Plus by holding your phone near a contactless reader. You can also use your phone, iPad Air™ and iPad Mini™ 3 to pay within certain apps.

2. What do I need to get started with Apple Pay?

- iPhone 6 or iPhone 6 Plus to pay in stores and within apps
- iPad Air 2 or iPad Mini 3 to pay within apps
- iOS 8.1 or later
- Touch ID™ or passcode on your device
- iCloud® account

3. Which CAMPUS USA Credit Union card can I use with Apple Pay?

You can use all CAMPUS USA Credit Union consumer credit and debit cards, as well as our Business credit and debit cards.

4. When I add my CAMPUS USA Credit Union card to Apple Pay it doesn't look like the card in my wallet. Why?

Apple Pay displays default images for all CAMPUS USA Credit Union Visa credit and debit cards, so the image displayed may not match the design of your physical card exactly.



5. How do I change my default card to my CAMPUS USA Credit Union card?

The credit or debit card associated with your iTunes® account or the first card you add to Passbook® is your default card. To change your default card:

1. Go to Settings > Passbook & Apple Pay.
2. Tap Default Card.
3. Choose a new card.

6. How do I replace my old CAMPUS USA Credit Union card with my new card on Apple Pay?

You'll delete the old card from Apple Pay and add the new card. To delete the old card, go into "Settings," open "Passbook & Apple Pay," select the card you want to delete and tap "Remove Card." To add your new card, simply follow the easy step instructions.

7. Are my payments safe with Apple Pay?

Yes. When you use Apple Pay, your CAMPUS USA Credit Union card number isn't stored on your phone or given to the merchant. A unique digital code is created specifically for that device. You still enjoy all the benefits of your CAMPUS USA Credit Union credit or debit card, which includes our Zero Liability policy that protects you from unauthorized purchases.

8. How are my privacy and personal information protected?

Since Apple Pay doesn't store your credit or debit card number on the device, you never reveal your name, card number or security code to merchants.

9. Am I able to opt out of Apple Pay at any time?

Adding your credit or debit cards to Apple Pay is your choice; you can add and remove cards when needed.

10. Which merchants are participating?

You can use Apple Pay at more than 220,000 locations, including Bloomingdale's®, McDonald's®, Macy's®, Nike®, DuaneReade™ and Staples®.

11. Is Apple Pay free?

Yes. Be aware that message and data rates may apply, depending on your data plan.
